

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS POLYURESTONE

Cleaning the Panels:

Using only basic natural soap and water to clean POLYURESTONE panels and keep them looking great. Prepare a bucket of soap and water and using a soft grade sponge simply wash from top to bottom on your Polyurestone wall surface cleaning the dirty areas, rinse with plain water and let to dry naturally. Repeat if necessary. To enable a thorough surface cleaning, recommended water sources are a standard garden hose or power washer using less than (<) **1000 PSI, DO NOT** use a more powerful washer as you may harm the surface.

GRAFFITI: If surface graffiti are not removed after this process is completed, you may treat the wall surface area using POLYURESTONE touch-up paint, please contact us for more information.

CAUTION: DO NOT use any harsh acids, bleach, chemicals and detergents as they are detrimental to POLYURESTONE panels, and will breakdown and damage the polyurethane composition and finishes. Do not sandblast the surface, as it will deteriorate the polyurethane.

POLYURESTONE panels are decorated using special formula high quality urethane pigment coatings that are mold and mildew resistant, durable and may be repaired if required.
